Key Responsibilities

Industry and Association Strengthening

- Support institutional and governance strengthening of the solar industry of Pakistan.
- Assist in expanding outreach and agency across manufacturers, EPCs, SMEs, and women/youth-led solar enterprises.
- Coordinate engagement between associations, think tanks, and civil society organizations.
- Facilitate strategic planning retreats, communication efforts, and member engagement initiatives.

Market Engagement and Advocacy

- Support dialogues between the industry and power sector regulators (NEPRA, ISMO, PPMC, AEDB) to enable flexibility, distributed solar, storage, and VPP models.
- Contribute to policy briefs, position papers, and stakeholder memos on market reforms, net-metering frameworks, and distributed generation integration.
- Track ongoing policy developments, regulatory consultations, and industry events to ensure timely engagement and response.



Partnership Building and International Collaboration

- Coordinate participation and representation in local and international networks and forums.
- Support planning and logistics for knowledge exchange events, side sessions, and South-South collaboration initiatives.
- Contribute to content and outreach for international media and campaigns.

Research and Communications Support

- Assist in preparing industry-facing reports and briefs.
- Maintain contact databases, communication trackers, and partnership records.
- Contribute to visual and written materials (infographics, event summaries, case studies) for internal and external audiences.
